1. Choose three characters from the play; have them meet at a time and place outside the action. Write about the encounter as a dialogue or a short story.
2. Help the characters find a new job. Draw up a résumé for Willy, Biff or Happy, showing their abilities and experiences in a positive light.
3. In the persona of a chosen character, write a song lyric or poem, or compose a short piece of music that reveals how the character feels about a particular situation in the play. Read or perform your work for the class.
4. Draw a picture or make a collage in response to the play or a particular scene, adding words from the script to the visual images.
